On the whole I consider the work submitted to be of aesthetic strength and worthy of attention. By singling out work for inclusion in the exhibition, I hope I have focused attention on the strongest efforts and not withheld the spotlight from the deserving. In the main I ranked less high those displays of technical excellence that projected a too usual content or lacked metaphorical extension. I gave greater applause to those works that seemed to evidence a grasp of pictorial space beyond local attachment. Clarity of premise was an important factor in my assessment, as was an avoidance of the too often chosen. A refreshing take on an old theme received high marks as did a sense of daring.
